The Emri Road Studio strives to provide a welcoming and supportive environment for a variety of learners and abilities. While staff may have personal experience working with individuals with learning differences or physical disabilities, they may not be licensed therapists, medical professionals, or special education providers.

Participants who require ongoing one-on-one assistance, behavioral support, personal care, mobility assistance, or individualized supervision may be asked to attend with a parent, guardian, aide, or caregiver to help ensure a safe and successful experience for everyone involved.

The studio is currently not wheelchair accessible and may have physical limitations that affect accessibility for some individuals. Families are encouraged to contact the Studio before registering so accommodations and space limitations can be discussed.
