Parent/Guardian Guidelines

Parents/guardians are welcome to observe the class as space allows; however, we kindly ask that observation remain unobtrusive so that young artists have the time and space they need to focus and create without unnecessary interruptions. To support a productive and distraction-free learning environment, parents may be asked to step out of the studio if their presence becomes disruptive. We appreciate your understanding in helping us maintain a calm, encouraging space for all students. (Weather permitting, our town has a beautiful park [just east on Main Street] where parents can retreat for a quiet hour while their child attends class. If weather isn't cooperative, Beans and Barley Brews [852 E Il-116] is a great place to enjoy a little me time over coffee or tea.)

Artist Class Guidelines & Expectations

At Emri Art Jr., we strive to create a welcoming and encouraging environment where every young artist feels safe to explore, create, and learn. Students are expected to show kindness and respect toward instructors, fellow artists, parents, and shared studio materials at all times.

Artists should arrive ready to participate and create. While some space is available for standing during projects, students are encouraged to remain at their tables during studio time so everyone can stay focused and engaged. Short movement breaks are welcome when needed, but should remain calm, quiet, and non-disruptive to the class environment.

Emri Road Art Studio is committed to maintaining a safe, encouraging, and respectful creative environment for all participants. Instructors reserve the right to dismiss students from class or future sessions in cases of ongoing disruptive, aggressive, disrespectful, or destructive behavior. If a student is asked to discontinue participation, any refund for remaining unused classes will be determined at the discretion of the studio, based on materials, preparation, and scheduling considerations.
