Studio Environment & Artwork Guidelines

At Emri Road Studio, we encourage creativity, individuality, and thoughtful self-expression. We also strive to maintain a welcoming, family-friendly studio environment that is respectful of the wide range of ages and backgrounds within our creative community.

Artwork containing graphic sexual content, nudity, hateful imagery, or excessively violent content is not appropriate for shared studio sessions or public display within the studio space.

Our goal is not to limit creativity, but to cultivate a studio atmosphere where artists can explore and grow within a space that feels safe, encouraging, and respectful for everyone.

Studio Conduct & Guidelines

Emri Road Studio maintains a respectful, safe, and productive environment for all participants. Disruptive, disrespectful, or destructive behavior will not be permitted, and participants may be asked to leave at the instructor's discretion.

In such cases, refunds or credits for remaining sessions are not guaranteed. The studio reserves the right to determine appropriate action, including situations involving misconduct or property damage.

Parent/Guardian Guidelines

Parents or guardians of children under the age of 7 or those who may need special assistance are expected to remain in the studio during class time, unless otherwise discussed with instructor. A comfortable seating area is available for waiting adults. If artshops are listed as for kids, parents/guardians of students in general are welcome to observe the class as space allows; however, we kindly ask that observation remain unobtrusive so that young artists have the time and space they need to focus and create without unnecessary interruptions. To support a productive and distraction-free learning environment, parents may be asked to step out of the studio if their presence becomes disruptive. We appreciate your understanding in helping us maintain a calm, encouraging space for all students.
